ESTIMATED SRI LANKA INTERNATIONAL ADOPTIONS FEES AND ESTIMATED COST SCHEDULE

REQUIREMENTS:

Prospective adoptive parents must be married for at least 2 years, be a minimum of 25 years old, special approval must be received for anyone over 40. Only relative and Sri Lankan Nationals are allowed to adopt from Sri Lanka. Sri Lanka is only open to families with no children. In accordance with New Horizons Adoption Agency, Inc. mission statement, our program is open to Christian families only.

TRAVEL:

Escorting is not allowed. Both parents must travel. The Approximate stary is four to six weeks.

CHILDREN AVAILABLE:

Children of all ages are available. Sibling groups and child with special needs may be available. The ethnic background is Singhalese or Tamil.

REFERRAL TIMES:

The average wait time for a referral is 2 to 5 years or longer. The average wait for referral to placement 6 months to 1 year.

Note: The following U.S. Agency Fees (NHAA Fees) and Foreign Country Program Expense fees will be paid directly to New Horizons by Adoptive Parents in installments listed below. NHAA does not use any of the fees to provide special services such as cultural programs for adoptees, scholarships, or other services.

The following New Horizons fees are estimated costs and are subject to change upon notification. Foreign fees and Third-party fees are set by the provider and subject to change without notification. **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE ONCE INVOICED AND PAID.**

If a child dies or the birthmother chooses to become re-involved prior to placement the family will be provided with the next available referral. No refund will be provided for a withdrawal. Any refunds will be made within 60 days. All other fees are non-refundable.
