## ESTIMATED UGANDA INTERNATIONAL ADOPTIONS FEES AND ESTIMATED COST SCHEDULE

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

Prospective adoptive parents must be married for at least 2 years, be a minimum of 25 years old, special approval must be received for anyone over 40. Uganda does not limit the number of children per family, but it is subject to a review by New Horizons Adoption Agency, Inc. In accordance with New Horizons Adoption Agency, Inc. mission statement, our program is open to Christian families only.

**TRAVEL:** Escorting is not allowed. Both parents must travel. Since the Children's Amendment Act passed, a minimum of 15 to 18 months stay in the country to foster the child will be required.

CHILDREN AVAILABLE: Children of all ages are available. Sibling groups may be available. The ethnic background is African.

**REFERRAL TIMES:** The average wait time for a referral of a child 2 years and older is 6 months to 1 year, a 6 month to 2 years is 1 to 2 years. The average wait from referral to placement is 6 months to a year.

Heritage Trip: Some judges require a "Heritage Trip" where one parent must travel back to Uganda every 5 years with the child until the child is 18 years old.

\* If the judge requires a "Heritage Trip" you MUST COMPLY. These Post Adoption Requirements must be taken seriously. If you cannot comply with these requirements Uganda may not be the best option for you. Please contact the International Coordinator or Executive Director if you have any questions.

Note: The following U.S. Agency Fees (NHAA Fees) and Foreign Country Program Expense fees will be paid directly to New Horizons by Adoptive Parents in installments listed below. NHAA does not use any of the fees to provide special services such as cultural programs for adoptees, scholarships, or other services.

The following New Horizons fees are estimated costs and are subject to change upon notification. Foreign fees and Third-party fees are set by the provider and subject to change without notification. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE ONCE INVOICED AND PAID.

If a child dies or the birthmother chooses to become re-involved prior to placement the family will be provided with the next available referral. No refund will be provided for a withdrawal. Any refunds will be made within 60 days. All other fees are non-refundable.

\$50 – 800 - Adoptive Family may be required to complete yearly progress reports of the child until he/she reaches the age of 18. These reports will be completed by the adoptive family and must include 4 – 6 quality photos, a medical report for the child, and a report card (if applicable). (Based on 1 – 16 yearly reports delivered @ \$50/report or current rate)

• If additional reports are required to be completed by a social worker, you will be charged \$300/report or current rate.

\* Uganda requires an adoptive family a minimum period of one year in country to foster a child they wish to adopt before giving approval for an adoption. Once a family has the approval, they may then apply to the Court to adopt the child. The entire process will require the adoptive family to live in Uganda for approximately 15 to 18 months to complete the adoption. This is just an estimate on the time and the time may be longer depending on approvals, court dates, witnesses, etc.
